QUARTZ LAYING INSTRUCTIONS

Start by getting the right Quartz countertop for your space

Quartz countertops are available in a variety of colors and patterns. Before installing the countertops, you should ensure you pick a colour and pattern that matches with the aesthetics of your home. With seemingly endless quartz countertop colour options, you'll have much to consider in your decision process. You must also work through the type of edging, cut-outs and backsplash that you want. It is important to have a clear vision of how your space should look after the quartz countertop installation. Passing on clear instructions and expectations to the fabricator will help eliminate any disappointments.

Prep your space

Before scheduling your quartz countertop installation, ensure you have a ready space. This prevents wastage of time and saves additional installation costs. Most new homeowners often think that cabinets are the only essential component when it comes to quartz countertop installations. For the most efficient quartz countertop installation, ensure that the flooring is finished, the wall paint is dry, and the plumbing and electrical work is complete.

Measure the size of the cabinets before purchasing your Quartz Slabs

Using a measuring tape, get precise cabinet top measurements. This is the most essential step prior to installation. Overestimating or underestimating your quartz slab's size can lead to inaccurate cuts and wasted quartz. Remember to carefully measure for the sink opening as well to ensure your quartz slab comes with an accurately sized space for the sink.

When purchasing your quartz slab, ensure to:

- Add an extra 1 or ½ inch to your measurements
- Choose between square, curved, or rounded edges for your quartz outer edges
- Use a 20 mm slab

Dry fit the Quartz Slab

Once you receive your quartz slab, fit it on the countertop by placing each slab on the installation area. Ensure the strength of base cabinet. This process is referred to as dry fitting and ensures that each piece of slab fits perfectly into its space without leaving spaces or gaps. Ensure color consistency of multiple slabs used for fittings. Although dry fitting is a simple procedure, it will require assistance from a professional fabricator since quartz slabs tend to be heavy.

Mark precise cut lines on the Quartz and shape it to the countertop

After dry fitting, you may need to make adjustments to fit the space exactly. If you find that the slab needs to be cut or trimmed, mark the regions with a straight edge and pencil, starting with the top and followed with the bottom. Mark the area on all four sides of the slab for the most accurate cut.

Use your diamond masonry blade attached to your power saw to saw along the marked regions

To ensure you work with a steady surface, use your left hand to hold the slab as your right hand moves the saw along each pencil mark and repeat on all ends.

You can now attach your Quartz countertop

If you had removed your kitchen sink when removing the old countertop material, reinstall it before installing the new quartz countertop. Use tape to protect the top edges of the cabinets. Covering the top of the cabinets is essential as it ensures that the silicone adhesive used does not come in contact with the edges.

Use ledgers to boost low cabinet support

Quartz countertops are heavy and weigh 4.54 kg per square foot. Although they are fully functional even when placed on top of the cabinets with no support, adding support to weak-looking regions is paramount. Ensure you also install ledgers with screws and an electric drill to provide added support.

Apply silicone adhesive in beads on the cabinet

You can start with 2–3 inches of adhesive on the cabinet corners and slowly work around the cabinet. To ensure that the quartz is securely held, space each adhesive bead by 6–12 inches. Do not wait for the adhesive to dry to remove the painter's tape as it will be more difficult.

You can now lay your Quartz on the cabinets

After applying the adhesive to the cabinet, place each slab over the beads. Ensure you do this before the adhesive dries. Follow by gently pressing the slab to the cabinet. Again, ensure you have a helping hand when placing the heavy quartz slabs on the cabinets.

Seal visible joints

For countertops that require multiple slabs, use epoxy adhesive at the seam. Apply a small amount of color-matched epoxy (epoxy color match with countertop color) to the edges that will be joined. Clamp the slabs together and wipe off any excess adhesive that may ooze out. Let it cure according to the adhesive manufacturer's instructions.

Safety Tips

- Always wear protective gear, including gloves, mask and safety goggles.
- Ensure slabs are handled with care, as quartz is heavy and can crack under incorrect handling.
- Use professional tools and equipment, especially when cutting, edging, Dhar Polish or drilling quartz.
- Do not open Protection film before installation is complete.

Maintenance and Care Tips

- Daily Cleaning: Use a soft cloth with mild soap and water.
- Prevent from Direct Heat: Always use trivets for hot cookware for longevity.
- Avoid Abrasives: Do not use scouring pads or harsh chemicals, as they may dull the finish.

What is Engineered Stone?

Engineered stone surfaces are manufactured by combining ground quartz aggregates with a small amount of polymer resins for binding and pigments for color. Natural Quartz is a crystalline Silicon Dioxide, which is usually white and transparent but may assume various colors depending on the natural mix. It is very hard, acid-resistant and offers a wide range of applications. Quartz is engineered stone and has approximately 93% natural quartz content.

How Durable is Quartz?

Quartz is a very hard material and has a high abrasion resistance. It is resistant to cracks and scratches. However, like most materials, excessive force and/or pressure from objects can damage the surface. Quartz is tough, but it is not indestructible. You need to care for your quartz surface to keep it in good shape. Quartz is non-porous and has a very low absorption rate. It is resistant to most stains caused by fruit juices, liquid food coloring, coffee, tea, and soft drinks. Its non-porous nature provides maximum resistance to staining and fully eliminates the need for any sealing. The non-porous quality of the surface also greatly reduces the potential for bacterial growth.

Quartz is resistant to acids. It does not affect household acids such as lemon, vinegar, wine etc. That quality alone makes it a very appropriate replacement for the white marble look in your kitchen. It is an excellent choice for people who love the luxuriant look of white marble but do not want to contend with the maintenance required for white marble kitchens.

Is Caring for Quartz Surface Really This Easy?

Quartz's is a low maintenance product. Due to its high density and non-porous qualities, normal cleaning with a damp cloth and mild detergent is all you need to keep your Quartz surface looking great. Thoroughly rinse off the soap/mild detergent with hot water after use and dry with soft cloth. To avoid dulling the surface shine, make sure to use a non-abrasive cleaner, and thoroughly rinse off with water after use. We recommend a thorough weekly cleaning to prevent patina that comes with daily use from forming, so you can keep your Quartz surface beautiful as the day it was installed.

Is Quartz Heat Resistant?

Quartz and all other commercially available quartz are structurally heat resistant up to 300 Fahrenheit or 150 Degree Celsius approx. It is not recommended to place hot pans and pots directly on the quartz surface, therefore use trivets or pads on your quartz surface. Sharp change of temperature may damage or discolor the surface. This refers to all commercially available quartz regardless of brand.

Are there any chemicals or cleaners to avoid on quartz?

We recommend using cleaning products with a pH between 5-8, as products outside this range may damage the surface. Cleaning products such as oven grill cleaners, floor strippers, toilet bowl cleaners, oil soaps, tarnish removers, furniture cleaners, drain products, etc. could be damaging to your countertop. If your surface accidentally is exposed to any of these potentially damaging products, rinse with water immediately.

In what areas of the home should quartz be used?

Quartz is perfect for kitchen counters, bathroom vanity tops, fireplaces, shower edges, Window sill and coffee tables. Using quartz in businesses for food service counters, conference tables and reception tops is also a popular choice. It is not recommended to use quartz for exterior purposes as too much exposure to ultraviolet light can discolor it.

Will any type of sink fit with a quartz countertop?

Yes, all types of sinks fit and will be measured and sized prior. Sink sizes are determined by the size of the sink cabinet. The sink needs to be on-site during installation to ensure proper fitting and sealing.

Do quartz countertops stain?

The quartz surface is non-porous and very resistant to staining. Even quartz counters can resist oil, coffee, wine, juice, and many other common kitchen spills. However, it is not 100% stain resistant and is susceptible to stains from solvents, sodium hydroxide, and permanent markers.

Can I cut directly on quartz countertops?

While quartz countertops are incredibly durable, it's not recommended to cut directly on the surface with sharp knives. Doing so can dull the blades of your knives and potentially cause scratches or damage to the countertop. Always use a cutting board to protect the surface and preserve its beauty.

Can quartz countertops be used outdoors?

Quartz countertops are not recommended for use in outdoor environments. Despite their high durability and engineering to withstand various conditions indoors, quartz countertops are not ideally suited for the challenges of outdoor settings, such as constant UV rays, temperature variations, and moisture. These elements can adversely affect their composition, leading to potential damage and diminished aesthetic quality over time. Therefore, alternative materials that are better suited to withstand the elements should be considered for outdoor kitchen spaces or patios.

What are the key benefits of having a quartz worksurface?

Because of the hardness of natural quartz, engineered quartz surfaces are hard-wearing, stain, scratch and heat resistant. Their non-porous properties mean that they are very hygienic as the build-up of bacteria or Mould is prevented and food can be placed in direct contact with the surface which helps keep your family safe.
